The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Department. The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- On February 8, 1999, Respondent, Craig Koller, (Date of Birth: September 10, 1974) was granted a Private Security Permit (#108-10221) by the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing. Mr. Koller's latest address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 935 West 4th Avenue, Oshkosh, Wisconsin 54902. The Department has learned that Craig Koller is presently incarcerated at the Corrections Corporation of America Prairie Correctional Facility, 445 South Munsterman Street, Appleton, MN 56208.
- On January 8, 2003, Respondent, Craig Koller, was convicted in Winnebago County Circuit Court of 4 counts of Felony 2nd Degree Sexual Assault of Child and two counts of Felony Possession of Child Pornography. A true and correct copy of the Criminal Complaint, Amended Criminal Complaint, Information, Judgment of Conviction – Sentence to Wisconsin State Prison and Extended Supervision and Judgment of Conviction – Sentence Withheld, Probation Ordered is attached as Exhibit A. Exhibit A is incorporated by reference into this Order.
- At no time did Respondent inform the Department of Regulation and Licensing of the felony convictions.
- In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- The Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Sec. 227.44(5), Stats.
- Sec. 440.26(6)(b), Stats. authorizes revocation of a security guard permit following a felony conviction.
- According to Sec. 440.26(4m)(b), Stats., and Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01(2), any person who holds a private security permit and is convicted of a felony shall notify the Department of Regulation and Licensing in writing within 48 hours after the entry of the judgment of conviction.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

- The Department ACCEPTS the SURRENDER of the private security permit of Respondent, Craig A. Koller (permit #108-10221).
- IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should Respondent, Craig A. Koller reapply for a Wisconsin Private security Permit, the Department of Regulation and Licensing may in its sole discretion determine, whether, and under what terms and conditions, this permit may be reissued.
- This Order shall become effective upon the date of signing.
