FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Melvin C. Saffold (applicant) whose address is 4055 N. 13th St., Milwaukee, WI 532209 holds Temporary Private Security Permit No. 25513 which was issued by the State of Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing (Department) under an Application For Private Security Permit for Issuance of a Temporary Permit and a Regular Permit, a copy of which is annexed hereto.

2. The Application for a Private Security Permit includes the following provisions:

“The Applicant agrees to accept a temporary private security permit subject to the terms and conditions set forth below:

“1) The permit is temporary upon successful completion of a FBI background search on the Applicant.

“2) Upon receipt of an adverse background report, the Department may, without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties issue an Order revoking the temporary permit. An Order issued pursuant to this paragraph will be sent to Applicant’s mailing address, and a copy shall be sent to Applicant’s Agency Employer.

3. The Department received information from the United States Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) which indicates the applicant has an outstanding warrant in Georgia.

A copy of the United States Department of Justice Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) is attached hereto.

4. Information received from the Georgia Corrections Corporation indicates that Melvin Safford was convicted of misdemeanor crimes – driving on a suspended license (2nd offense) and speeding on March 24, 1997. Mr. Saffold currently has a warrant for his arrest due to his failure to report and make payments.

5. The Department has not received any evidence that the arrest warrant has been removed.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

A. Applicant has not met the condition in the Order that requires successful completion of a FBI background search on the Applicant.

B. Applicant did not notify the department of his misdemeanor convictions in Georgia.

C. On the basis of the criminal history report described in paragraph 3. of the FINDINGS OF FACT, above, applicant is not eligible for a permit under sec. 440.26, Stats.

D. The Department has authority to issue the following Order under sec. 440, Stats.

ORDER

Now, Therefore, It Is Ordered That the Temporary Private Security Permit No. 25513 of Melvin C. Saffold is REVOKED and Applicant Melvin C. Saffold shall cease and desist from acting as a private security person and from engaging in private security activities in Wisconsin.

It Is Further Ordered That Applicant shall have an opportunity to challenge the accuracy of the information contained in the criminal history report described in paragraph 3. Of the FINDINGS OF FACT, above by submitting information to the Administrator, Division of Business Licensure and Regulation, P.O. Box 8935, Madison WI 53708-8935 within 10 days after the date of signing, below.

It Is Further Ordered That Revocation of the Applicant's temporary private security permit shall become effective on the tenth day after the date of signing, below.

It Is Further Ordered That Applicant shall immediately return the wallet size conditional private security permit and the 3 ½ x 5 ¼ wall certificate to the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Attention: Jan Bobholz, P.O. Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.
