The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Deborah L. Cravilion (Date of Birth: February 27, 1952) is duly licensed as a Registered Nurse in the state of Wisconsin (license #89501). This license was first granted on October 25, 1984.
- 2. Ms. Cravilion's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is 223 East River Road, DePere, Wisconsin, 54115.
- 3. At all times relevant to this action Ms. Cravilion worked as a registered nurse at Odd Fellow Home, 1229 South Jackson Street, Green Bay, WI 54301-6523.
- 4. On January 31, Ms. Cravilion was caring for HY, an 87-year-old man, when HY became short of breath while in the dinning room. Later that evening HY's wife informed Ms. Cravilion that HY had a painful swollen knot on his leg. The Respondent did not assess HY's swollen leg nor did she inform anyone else of HY's change of condition. HY had a diagnosi of a leg blood clot.
 - 5. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Cravilion consents to the issuance of the following Conclusions of Law and Order:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction over this matter, pursuant to sec. 441.07, Wis. Stats.
- 2. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing is authorized to enter into the attached stipulation, pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Wis.

Stats.

3. The conduct described in paragraph 3, above, violated §N 7.04 (4) and (15), Wis. Adm. Code and sec. 441.07(1)(d), Wis. Stats.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Deborah L. Cravilion be Reprimanded.

IT IS ALSO FURTHER ORDERED that the Wisconsin license (#89501) of Deborah L. Cravilion to practice as a registered nurse is hereby LIMITED as follows:

Education

1. Within twelve (12) months from the effective date of this Order, Ms. Cravilion shall submit documentation of successful completion of at least six (6) hours of continuing nursing education approved by the Board in the subject areas of assessment and treatment of circulatory disorders. To be acceptable, a course shall be pre-approved by a member or designated agent of the Board of Nursing. Acceptable documentation shall include certification from the sponsoring organization as well as a statement signed by Ms. Cravilion verifying that she attended the course in its entirety.

Required reporting

2. Respondent shall notify the Department Monitor of any change of employment during the time in which the Order is in effect. Notification shall occur within fifteen (15) days of a vchange of employment and shall include an explanation of the reasons for the change.

Department Monitor

3. The Department Monitor is the individual designated by the Board as its agent to coordinate compliance with the terms of this Order, including coordinating submission of reports and petitions. The Department Monitor may be reached as follows:

SUMMARY SUSPENSION

4. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license pursuant to the procedures set forth in Wis. Admin. Code RL Ch. 6. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order.

Termination of restrictions

5. Upon completion of the terms of this Order; Ms. Cravilion may petition the Board to revise or eliminate any of the above conditions. Denial in whole or in party of a petition under this paragraph shall not constitute denial of a license and shall not give rise to a contested case within the meaning of Wis. Stats. §§227.01(3) and 227.42.
