The parties in this matter, William F. Taccolini, R.Ph., Respondent, and David A. Hart, attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. William F. Taccolini, R.Ph., Respondent herein, of 513 46th Avenue, Menominee, Michigan 49858, whose date of birth is July 9, 1953, is licensed and currently registered as a pharmacist in the State of Wisconsin under license # 10963 which was granted on June 18, 1985.
 - 2. A formal investigation, entitled 03 PHM 51, is pending before the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board.
 - 3. Respondent was the Managing Pharmacist of Bay Area Medical Center Pharmacy during the time that this incident occurred.
- 4. From May of 2002 thru January of 2003 Respondent allowed an individual without a valid Wisconsin pharmacist license to work at the Bay Area Medical Center Pharmacy as a pharmacist. This individual was granted a Wisconsin pharmacist license on September 3. 2003.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board has jurisdiction in this proceeding pursuant to Wis. Stats. Sec. 450.10.
- 2. The Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board has the authority to resolve this proceeding by Stipulation without an evidentiary hearing pursuant to Wis. Stats. Sec. 227.44(5).
- 3. Respondent's conduct of allowing an unlicensed pharmacist to work as a pharmacist constituted a violation of Wis. Adm. Code Sec. Phar 10.03(10).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Stipulation of the parties is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that William F. Taccolini, R.Ph. is REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall pay COSTS in the amount of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY dollars (\$250.00).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall pay a FORFEITURE in the amount of ONE THOUSAND dollars (\$1,000.00).

Payment shall be submitted within sixty (60) days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by certified check or money order, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to: Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, Dept. of Regulation & Licensing, P. O. Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.

The rights of a party aggrieved by this Final Decision and Order to petition the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board for rehearing and to petition for judicial review are set forth in the attached "Notice of Appeal Information".
