The Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board received a Stipulation submitted by the parties to the above-captioned matter. The Stipulation, a copy of which is attached hereto, was executed by George E. Warren, D.D.S., personally on his own behalf, and by Michael J. Berndt, attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement. Based upon the Stipulation of the parties, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. George E. Warren, D.D.S. was born May 19, 1943. Dr. Warren's latest address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 8309 Greenway Blvd., Middleton, WI 53562.
2. Dr. Warren's license to practice dentistry in the state of Wisconsin was first granted on June 19, 19 67.
3. From September 30, 2001 and continuing on through August 5, 2002, Dr. Warren practiced with an expired Wisconsin dentistry license #15-5000477. Dr. Warren's failure to renew was unintentional.
4. In resolution of this matter, Dr. Warren consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Dentistry Examining Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to § 447, Stats.
2. The conduct described in paragraph 3 in the Findings of Fact constitutes unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Adm. Code § DE 5.02 (26).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation of the parties is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that George E. Warren, D.D.S. is hereby REPRIMANDED.

Dr. Warren shall, within six (6) months from the date of this Order, pay a forfeiture of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) and pay the costs associated with this proceeding in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) to be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:
