On December 15, 2004, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board considered information regarding the petitioner's non-compliance with the Board order dated September 15, 2004, and her ineligibility for a further stay of the suspension of her limited license. The information indicated that the petitioner had failed to abide by the call-in protocol for her urine screens, failed to attend therapy at the frequency required, failed to obtain pre-approval for her work setting, failed to arrange for billing, bookkeeping and accounting services if she engaged in solo practice, and failed to pay the costs of the investigation and prosecution of her disciplinary case, which was assessed by the Board. Based upon all information of record herein, the Board finds and enters the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that a further three month stay of the suspension of the license of ROBIN R. FERRON, MD, (lic.# 25927), is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petitioner must show three months compliance with the terms and conditions of her Board order prior to her next petition for a further stay.

This Order shall be presumed effective five (5) days from the date signed below.
