The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subj the approval of the Board . The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. **Debra A. Leciejewski-Noskoviak** ("Noskoviak"), a/k/a Debra A. Noskoviak-Gillott, date of birth 10/04/69, is a lic real estate broker in the State of Wisconsin, license # 90-50329, which was first granted on 08/30/00 and is currently expired a 01/01/03. Noskoviak's most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 220 Chapel Ave., Apt Ashland, WI 54806.
- 2. At all times relevant to the facts set forth below Noskoviak was the real estate Broker/Owner of Struthers Realty LLC located at 1110 Lakeshore Dr. W., Ashland, WI 54806, licensed as a Real Estate Business Entity having license # 91-700342 was first granted on 05/04/00 and is currently expired as of 01/01/03.
- 3. On or about April 20, 2002, Noskoviak received a check for \$200.00 as earnest money from John Petras Sr. Instead placing the earnest money into a real estate trust account, Noskoviak used the \$200.00 to pay her personal bills.

- 4. On or about May 18, 2002, Noskoviak received a check for \$500.00 as earnest money from Tim and Laurie Bauer. of placing the earnest money into a real estate trust account, Noskoviak used the \$500.00 to pay her personal bills.
- 5. On or about December 5, 2000, Noskoviak was convicted in the State of Wisconsin Circuit Court Branch 1 in Ashlan County for violating Wis. Statute 943.20(1)(b)-Theft-Business Setting <=\$2500 and Wis. Statute 943.20(1)(a) Theft-Movable Property <=\$2500. The violations were committed on or between April 20, 2002 and October 2002. Sentence was withheld conviction and Noskoviak was placed on 18 months probation.
- 6. Noskoviak has offered to resolve this investigation by the Voluntary Surrender of the Right To Renew her real estate be license # 90-50329 and the Voluntary Surrender of the Right To Renew the real estate business entity license issued to Struther Realty LLC., # 91-700342, pursuant to the terms of the Order set forth below.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Wisconsin Real Estate Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to sec. 452.14, Wis. Stats.
- 2. The Wisconsin Real Estate Board is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Wis. §
- 3. Respondent Debra A. Leciejewski-Noskoviak has violated:
  - a. Section RL 18.031(1) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code and section 452.14(3) of the Wisconsin Statues be failing to deposit earnest money in a real estate trust account.
  - b. Section RL 24.17(1) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code and section 452.14(3)(i) of the Wisconsin Statues having been convicted on December 30, 2003, for violating Wis. Statute 943.20(1)(b)-Theft-Business Setting <=\$250 Wis. Statute 943.20(1)(a) Theft-Movable Property <=\$2500, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the pra of real estate.

#### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of Respondent **Debra A. Leciejewski-Noskoviak's** To Renew her Real Estate Broker's license # 90-50329 is hereby accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of Respondent **Struthers Realty LLC.**, Right To Rer Business Entities license # 91-700342 is hereby accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent Debra A. Leciejewski-Noskoviak, will not practice or attempt to practice as a estate agent in the State of Wisconsin when not currently registered.

The rights of a party aggrieved by this Final Decision and Order to petition the Wisconsin Real Estate Board for rehearing and petition for judicial review are set forth in the attached "Notice of Appeal Information".

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that files 02REB166 and 02REB173 be, and hereby are, closed.
