The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of Secretary. The Secretary has reviewed the Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Secretary adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent MedRx Pharmaceuticals Distributors, Inc., ("MedRx") is an Illinois corporation having a principal place of business at 12 Ac Butterfield Center Plaza, Glen Ellyn, IL 60137. The corporation is an Illinois licensed drug wholesale distributor.
- 2. Beginning in M ay of 2002, and continuing through M ay of 2004, M edRx sold a limited line of non-controlled prescription pharmaceuticals to re pharmacies in Wisconsin.
- 3. At no time has MedRx been licensed by the Pharmacy Examining Board as a distributor under Chapter 450, Wis. Stats., nor has any employee any respondent been licensed in Wisconsin as a distributor.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 4. The sale and delivery of a prescription drug to a retail pharmacy constitutes "distributing" pursuant to § 450.01 Wis. Stats. Distributing prescription drug may only be performed by a person licensed to distribute such drugs. § 450.07, Wis. Stats.
- 5. The conduct of respondents set forth in paragraphs 2 through 3 above constitutes distributing a prescription drug without a required credentia violation of § 440.07, Wis. Stats.
  - 6. The department has authority to issue this Administrative Injunction as a special order under § 440.21, Wis. Stats., and Ch. RL 3, Wis. Adm. Co.

#### **ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED, that the attached stipulation is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that MedRx Pharmaceuticals Distributors, Inc. is enjoined and prohibited from the distribution of any prescription drug, persona or through employees, agents, business entities, and contractors, in Wisconsin, and from doing any act which may constitute the distribution of any prescript drug in Wisconsin, unless and until properly credentialed to do so. Violation of this special order may result in a forfeiture of up to \$10,000 for each day violation (§ 440.21(4)(a), Wis. Stats.).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that if the secretary determines that there is probable cause to believe that respondent has violated any terms of this final decisi and order, the secretary may order that the violations covered by this decision and order be referred to any appropriate prosecutorial unit for review for possil criminal charges.
