PROCEDURAL HISTORY

A Settlement Conference was held in this matter on December 1, 2004. As a result, the parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Veterinary Examining Board ("Board"). The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this mater adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Liane A. Wilkinson, D.V.M., (D.O.B. July 29, 1959) is duly licensed as a veterinarian in the state of Wisconsin (license # 4334). This license was first granted on June 9, 1995.
- 2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board is W4726 5th Ave., Trego, WI 54888.
- 3. On Friday November 2, 2001, a ten month old Shetland sheep dog presented with a puncture wound in its chest. Respondent took a radiograph of the dog, but failed to detect a penetrating wound in the thoracic cavity that would have required more extensive care then the Respondent provided.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board has jurisdiction in this proceeding pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 453.04.
- 2. The Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board has authority to resolve this proceeding by stipulation without an evidentiary hearing pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

REMEDIAL ORDER FOR EDUCATION

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Liane A. Wilkinson, D.V.M., shall, within nine (9) months from the date of this Final Decision and Order, submit acceptable documentation of successful completion of continuing education pre-approved by the Board or of other training pre-approved by the Board in three different areas: Thoracic radiology; Critical care of small animals, including anesthesia; and Record keeping. Acceptable documentation of completion of continuing education shall include: certification from the sponsoring organization as well as a statement signed by respondent verifying her attendance at the course and completion of course requirements. This education is in addition to the continuing education requirement to maintain licensure.
- 2. The Department Monitor is the individual designated by the Board as its agent to coordinate compliance with the terms of this Order, including receiving reports and coordinating all requests for approval of education or other petitions. The Department Monitor may be reached as follows:

3. Liane A. Wilkinson, D.V.M. will be responsible for paying the full cost of attendance at these courses.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

4. Liane A. Wilkinson, D.V.M. shall, within six (6) months from the date of this Order, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00). Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:

- 5. In the event Liane A. Wilkinson, D.V.M. fails to timely pay costs as ordered or fails to comply with the ordered continuing education, Respondent's license (# 4334) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order. The Board or its designee will remove the suspension, if provided with sufficient information that Respondent is in compliance with the Order and that it is inappropriate for the suspension to remain in effect. The Board in its discretion may impose additional conditions and limitations for a violation of any of the terms of this Order
- 6. Liane A. Wilkinson, D.V.M. is responsible for compliance with all of the terms and conditions of this Final Decision and Order.
- 7. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
