On June 24, 2004, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Charlene Willis, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension of her license to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* (“Order”) dated October 10, 1995. Also requested by Willis was an unspecified modification of the number of hours that she can work per week as a pharmacist in charge, and an unspecified modification of her current requirement for individual/group therapy. Willis’ individual/group therapy counseling sessions are currently set at a frequency of one time (1x) per month by previous board order dated December 10, 2003. The therapist report form dated May 10, 2004, indicates that Willis attended a therapy session on December 20, 2003, and February 27, 2004. Based upon the board’s review:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Charlene Willis, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #11555 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request that the board modify the individual/group therapy counseling sessions from the current frequency of one time (1x) per month, is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for an increase in the number of hours practicing as a pharmacist in charge is denied.
