On May 1, 1997, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require that she complete continuing education within six months, that she complete community service within one year, that she submit quarterly reports from her employer, and that she practice only in settings approved by the board. Because she failed to comply with these requirements, Ms. Wright's license was subsequently suspended on july 19, 1998.

By letter dated October 19, 2000, Ms. Wright petitioned the board for reinstatement of her license. She was to appear in support of her petition, but failed to make an appearance. Accordingly, it is ordered as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that respondent's petition for reinstatement of her license is denied.
