On December 9, 2004, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing considered the request of the petitioner, Mary E. Trahan, R.N, for a further three month stay of the suspension of her limited license and termination of her therapy and drug screens, pursuant to the Order dated November 27, 1997, currently in effect against her. Based upon all information of record herein, showing that the petitioner is in compliance with the terms and conditions of her limited license, and that there exists sufficient support for modification of her therapy, the Board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for a stay of the suspension of the limited license of MARY E. TRAHAN, R.N., (lic. #92148) to practice as a RN in the state of Wisconsin is hereby GRANTED for a period of three months.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to terminate therapy requirement is GRANTED, but the petitioner's request for reduction in her urine screens is DENIED and she must enroll with First Lab or a pre-approved provider for her urine testing.
