On February 11, 2004, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the petition by Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* (“*Order*”) dated December 8, 1998, LS 9812084 PHM. Also requested by Iverson were a reduction in urine screens required by the *Order* and the granting of hours worked as a pharmacist in charge.

Based upon the board's review and consideration of the current petitions and supporting documentation:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #8239 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the request for a reduction in urine screens required by the *Order* and the granting of hours worked as a pharmacist in charge, is denied.
