On April 7, 2004, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by William Karwoski, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* (“*Order*”) dated March 10, 1999, and that the board further reduce urine screens required by the *Order* to an unspecified amount.. Also requested was the removal of any restrictions from acting as a pharmacist in charge, (paragraph 2.c.(3)), and a reduction in individual/group therapy to one time, (1x) per month, (paragraph 2.b.(2)).

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that William Karwoski, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #9334 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to further reduce urine screens required by the *Order*, is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to the remove the restrictions from acting as a pharmacist in charge, (paragraph 2.c.(3)), is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for a reduction in individual/group therapy to one time per month, (paragraph 2.b.(2)), is granted.
