On October 13, 2004, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by William Karwoski, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("*Order*") dated March 10, 1999, and that the board further reduce urine screens required by the *Order* from four times per month to two times per month. The request was supported by a practitioner. Also requested was the removal of any restrictions from acting as a pharmacist in charge, (paragraph 2.c.(3)), which was supported by his employer and a practitioner. (Currently 8 hours per week are authorized as a pharmacist in charge.)

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that William Karwoski, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #9334 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to further reduce urine screens required by the *Order*, is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to the remove the restrictions from acting as a pharmacist in charge, (paragraph 2.c.(3)), is denied.
