On March 3, 2004, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by Michael S. Mecikalski, D.D.S., for a four-month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided in the Board's *Final Decision and Order* dated May 5, 1999.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the urinalysis screenings (UAs) of Michael S. Mecikalski, D.D.S., shall continue on a weekly, random basis.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Michael S. Mecikalski, D.D.S., shall continue his monthly therapy sessions.
