PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On September 10, 2002, the Department of Regulation and Licensing issued its Order Adopting the Stipulation in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the Department's order, applicant's license (#106-1189) to practice as a home inspector in Wisconsin was granted under certain limiting conditions. The Order provided that failure by applicant Jones to timely comply with the terms of this limitation and/or any further criminal conviction shall result in the revocation of applicant Jones' limited home inspector registration without further notice or hearing or other proceeding.

On September 16, 2005, the Department found that Mr. Jones had failed to file the necessary semi-annual reports with the Department. The Department also found that according to the Wisconsin Circuit Court Access website, Mr. Jones was charged with two criminal offenses in January of 2005, which he failed to report to the Department.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the limited home inspector registration of Kenneth L. Jones (#106-1189) is REVOKED.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
