CONCLUSION

The Executive Committee concludes that the respondent did sign the name of a client on a ISP and that the respondent stipulated to the allegations.

Therefore, the respondent is found to have breached the following Rule within the *Counselor Code of Conduct*:

Rule 2.2 A counselor shall not engage in conduct, which does not meet the generally accepted standards of practice;

Rule 5.5 A counselor shall not sign or issue in the counselor's professional capacity a document that the counselor knows or should have know to contain a false or misleading statement.

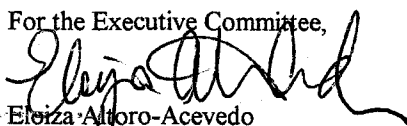
DECISION
