On October 19, 2005, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Michael J. O'Kray, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order*, ("*Order*") dated July 11, 2000, case number LS 0007112 PHM. Also requested was the granting of additional hours to be worked as a pharmacist in charge (currently at sixteen (16)), and termination of the requirement that he participate in individual/group therapy as required by the *Order*. Base upon the board's review:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Michael J. O'Kray, R.Ph., is granted a three month stay of the suspension of license #9415, to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that Michael J. O'Kray, R.Ph., is granted eight (8) additional hours per week to work as a pharmacist in charge, for a total of twenty four (24), and may open or close a pharmacy but not consecutively.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the requirement for participation in individual/group therapy provided in paragraph 2b.(2), of the *Order*, is terminated. O'Kray must still comply with paragraph 2b.(3) of the *Order* and attend two AA meetings per week and submit attendance records for those AA meetings to the department monitor quarterly.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that O'Kray's drug urine screens required by the *Order* shall be at the frequency of twenty four (24) per year.
