On June 22, 2005, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the petition of Michael J. O'Kray, R.Ph., for the restoration of a full unlimited license to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") June 11, 2000. The Order provides in part:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that effective on the date of this Order, the pharmacist license of respondent is SUSPENDED for a period of not less than five (5) years. The Board in its discretion may restore respondent's license to full, unlimited status only upon petition by respondent after completion of five years of practice of pharmacy in compliance with all terms and conditions of this Order, and a demonstration that respondent may practice pharmacy without condition or limitation with skill and safety to patient and public.

The Board reviewed information presented by the department monitor that O'Kray had been unemployed as a pharmacist from November 20, 2004 to the present. Therefore, he has not practiced pharmacy in compliance with all terms and conditions of the *Order* for a period of 5 years. The Board reviewed additional information indicating that O'Kray pled no contest to a charge of Operating While Intoxicated (1st) on April 26, 2002, and did not report the plea to the Board. Based upon the Board's review of the petition and other evidence:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Michael J. O'Kray, R.Ph., is granted a three month stay of the suspension of license #9415, to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, and is denied an unlimited license, #9415, to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that Michael J. O'Kray, R.Ph., is granted sixteen (16) hours per week to work as a pharmacist in charge but may not open or close a pharmacy consecutively.
