On June 22, 2005, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Thomas G. Pire, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension of his license to practice pharmacy, as provided by the terms of the board's *Final Decision and Order*, ("*Order*") dated October 10, 2001. Also requested was termination of the weekly individual/group therapy required by the *Order*, which was supported by his therapist. Pire is currently required to attend individual/group therapy once (1x) per week. Also requested was a reduction in the frequency of drug urine screens as required by the Order to a frequency of seventy two (72) times per year.

Based upon the board's review:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Thomas G. Pire, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license # 9468 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the request to terminate individual/group therapy sessions a required by paragraph 2.b.(2) of the *Order*, is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the request to reduce the required drug screen testing as provided by the *Order*, is granted, with the new frequency to be seventy two (72) times per year.
