On September 7, 2005, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Donald R. Leetz, for a continued three month stay of suspension as provided in the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated December 11, 2001. ("Order"). Mr. Leetz also requested eight, (8), additional hours per week to be worked as a pharmacist in charge. [Currently at four, (4), hours per week.]

Based upon a review of the petition and supporting documentation submitted:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Donald R. Leetz, R.Ph., is GRANTED a three month stay of the suspension of license #10190 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Donald R. Leetz, R.Ph., is GRANTED an additional eight, (8), hours per week to work as a pharmacist in charge, for a total of twelve, (12).
