As reported by the department monitor to the board liaison for monitoring, test results for drug and alcohol monitoring for Lance J. Lundstad evidence that on May 4, 2005, Lundstad tested positive for ethanol at a rate of .089. The board liaison for monitoring therefore finds that Lance J. Lundstad is in violation of paragraph 2.a. of the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated June 12, 2002. ("Order") Based on the foregoing:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that pursuant to paragraph 8 of the *Order*, the stay of suspension for Lance J. Lundstad of license # 12304, to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin, is hereby TERMINATED by action of the board liaison for monitoring.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the board, the termination of the stay of suspension of Lance J. Lundstad shall be reviewed by the board for further action.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That Lance J. Lundstad shall provide a copy of this order to any employer for which he is currently working.

PLEASE BE ADVISED: Pursuant to paragraph 8 of the *Order* a licensee who has a stay of suspension terminated pursuant to paragraph 8 has the opportunity to be heard before the board. The next regularly scheduled board meeting is June 22, 2005.
