On September 8, 2005, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for a further three month stay of the suspension of her license and a reduction in her urinalysis screens. Based upon the information presented in support of the petition showing her possible non-compliance with the terms and requirements of the original order regarding her random drug screens, the Board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for a three month stay of the suspension of the license of Rebecca L. Thomas (# 104025) and the request for a reduction in the frequency of her random drug screens is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner shall be GRANTED a stay of suspension for a period of one (1) month.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner shall obtain a valid medical explanation from her licensed physician as to her low creatine level drug screens for the past three months. Upon presentation of this information to the Board, petitioner may request a further stay of the suspension of her limited license.
