On July 18, 2005, the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned proceedings. This Order was served by mail upon respondent on July 19, 2005. On August 5, 2005, the Department received Respondent's Petition for Rehearing.

It is clear from the petition that Respondent disagrees with the findings made against him, and that he now feels he would like to retry the matter with counsel. Respondent, however, was given ample opportunity to retain counsel during the pendency of these proceedings. The petition for rehearing does not present a sufficient basis for granting a rehearing based upon a material error or law, a material error of fact, or the discovery of new evidence sufficiently strong to reverse or modify the order, and which could not have been previously discovered by due diligence. Wis. Stats., § 227.49 (3).

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Respondents' petition for rehearing is DENIED.
