The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision and order in this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has recommended the terms of this final decision and order, as stipulated, and finds it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

# **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. Maria K. Zeinz (dob:5/8/74) is and was at all times relevant to the facts set forth herein a registered nurse license in the State of Wisconsin pursuant to license #134386. This license was first granted on March 3, 2000.
- 2. On September 16, 2004, the Board of Nursing entered an order limiting the respondent's license as result of he inability to practice safely and reliably due to her opioid dependence and drug diversion.
- 3. The respondent has now indicated that she would prefer to voluntarily surrender her license rather than comply with the conditions of her limited license.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

A. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to §441.07(1)(b)(c) and(d) Wis Stats. and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to §227.44(5), Wis. Stats.

#### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation for VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of the respondent's license is accepted.

IT IS FUTHER ORDERED that respondent may not reapply for RN licensure in the future.

This Order shall become effective five days after the date of its signing.
