#### **PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

A hearing in the above-captioned matter was held on January 20, 2005, before Administrative Law Judge Jacquelynn B. Rothstein. The Division of Enforcement appeared by Attorney David Hart. Mr. Greguire did not appear. The Administrative Law Judge's proposed decision was filed on January 28, 2005. The Board considered the proposed decision at its meeting on May 2, 2005.

Based on the entire record in this case, the Hearing and Speech Examining Board adopt as its final decision in this matter the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. Timothy M. Greguire (dob 9/15/65) is duly licensed as a hearing instrument specialist in Wisconsin (License No. 1191). His license was first granted on March 3, 2001.
- 2. Mr. Greguire's most recent address on file with the Hearing and Speech Examining Board is 1022 Plummer Street, Wausau, Wisconsin.
- 3. On September 3, 2004, Mr. Greguire pled no contest in Case No. 2004CM256 to one count of disorderly conduct contrary to section 947.01, Wis. Stats. His plea was entered in Marathon County Circuit Court.
- 4. On October 21, 2003, Mr. Greguire pled no contest in Case No. 2003CM515 to one count of battery and to one count of disorderly conduct contrary to sections 940.19 (1) and 947.01, Wis. Stats. His pleas were entered in Marathon County Circuit Court.
- 5. On October 9, 2002, Mr. Greguire pled no contest in Case No. 2002CT90 to one count of operating a vehicle while

intoxicated—second offense contrary to section 346.63 (1) (a), Wis. Stats. His plea was entered in Marathon County Circuit Court.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Hearing and Speech Examining Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to §459.10, Wis. Stats.
- 2. By having engaged in the conduct as set forth in Findings of Fact 3-5, Mr. Greguire has committed unprofessional conduct contrary to sec. 459.10, Wis. Stats.

#### **ORDER**

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the license of Timothy M. Greguire to practice as a hearing instrument specialist in the State of Wisconsin shall be **REVOKED**, beginning the date on which this Order is signed.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the assessable costs of this proceeding be imposed upon Timothy M. Greguire, pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats.

#### **EXPLANATION OF VARIANCE**

The Board adopts the proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order recommended by the Administrative Law Judge with one exception. Paragraph 1 of the proposed Conclusions of Law states that the Hearing and Speech Examining Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to s. 441.07, Wis. Stats. The Board amends paragraph 1 of the proposed Conclusions of Law to state that the Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to s. 459.10, Stats.
