**PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Chiropractic Examining Board. The Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Jeffery M. Wilder, (DOB 5/30/1957) is duly licensed as chiropractor in the State of Wisconsin (license #1707). This license was first granted on 11/12/1981.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board is 4101 East Towne Blvd, Madison, WI 53704-3792
3. At all times relevant to this action, Respondent was working as a chiropractor in Madison, Wisconsin.
4. A disciplinary complaint was filed against Respondent alleging, among other things, inadequate record keeping as required by Wis. Admin. Code §§ CHIR 6.02(3) and CHIR 11.02(1).
5. An additional investigative file relating to Respondent's record keeping was opened as 02 CHI 033.
6. Respondent denied the allegations against him and has expert witnesses who support Respondent's contention that his record keeping does not violate the Chiropractic Examining Board Rules and Regulations.
7. Respondent completed an eight hour record keeping course conducted by John B. Wolfe, Jr. D.C., on June 21, 2005. This course content covered the records keeping concerns of the cases under investigation.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The Chiropractic Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to sec. 446.03(5), Stats.
2. The Board is authorized pursuant to sec 227.44(5), Stats. To enter into the attached Stipulation and Order.

**ORDER**

1. The Respondent's continuing education course attended June 21, 2005, satisfies the record keeping concerns of the Chiropractic Examining Board.
2. The disciplinary complaint against Respondent is dismissed, and investigative file 02 CHI 022 is closed. No costs shall be awarded to either party.
3. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
