The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Thomas K. Cain, D.D.S., P.O. Box 8220, Janesville, Wisconsin 53547, whose date of birth is April 14, 1953, is currently licensed to practice dentistry in the State of Wisconsin under license #5002110 which was granted on June 27, 1978.
- 2. An investigation entitled 01DEN105 is pending before the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board. The investigation includes issues of sanitary conditions and proper control practices in dentistry. Dr. Cain takes issue with the investigation.
- 3. An inspection of the Respondent's dental office was done on February 4, 2003. Dr. Cain was not furnished with a copy of the report of the inspection.
- 4. Thomas K. Cain, D.D.S., has cooperated in the investigation and has voluntarily agreed in the resolution of the matters contained herein.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board has jurisdiction in this proceeding pursuant to Wis. Stats. §447.04.
- 2. The Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board has the authority to resolve this matter by stipulation without an

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Stipulation of the parties, as attached hereto, is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that:

- 1. Within sixty (60) days of the date of this order, Elise Sampson, D.D.S., of Marquette University Dental School shall inspect the office sanitation and infectious measures of the Cain Dental Office located 2233 Cranston Road, Beloit, Wisconsin, during regular business hours while patient care is being provided.
- 2. Respondent shall ensure that Dr. Sampson conducts the investigation within 60 days of the date of this Order and submits a written report to the Dentistry Examining Board setting forth her findings within 15 days of completion of the inspection. This report will be filed with:

All documents required to be filed with the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board will be deemed filed with the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board upon receipt by the Department Monitor.

- 3. Respondent is responsible for payment of all costs associated with Dr. Sampson's inspection and report.
- 4. Respondent will ensure that all of Dr. Sampson's recommendations following her inspection are fully implemented and complied with at Cain Dental Office.
- 5. Respondent shall conform to the CDC Guidelines for Infection Control in Dental Health Settings (dated December 19, 2003) commencing on the effective date of this Order.
- 6. Respondent will submit to one (1) unannounced inspection by the Dentistry Examining Board or its designee within six (6) months of the effective date of this Order to determine compliance with the standards set forth in the CDC Guidelines for Infection Control in Dental Health Care Settings and any recommendations contained in Dr. Sampson's report. Respondent will be responsible for paying for the full cost of the required inspection and shall be furnished with copies of any and all reports or documents generated as a result of such inspection within 15 days of completion of the inspection.
- 7. Respondent shall voluntarily pay costs in the amount of Two Hundred, fifty dollars (\$250.00) payable to the Department of Regulation and Licensing, 1400 East Washington Avenue, P.O. Box 8935, Madison, Wisconsin 53708, within 15 days after this Order is entered and copy sent to Attorney James D. Wickhem.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the pending investigation of 01DEN105 is closed without further proceedings.
