PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Pharmacy Examining Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Hauper Pharmacy is duly licensed as a pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin (license #42-8389). This license was first granted on April 8, 2004.
2. Hauper Pharmacy, previously located at 1014 Vine Street, Union Grove, WI 53182, was duly licensed as a pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin pursuant to license #42-7461. This license was granted on May 9, 1995. Hauper Pharmacy ceased operations at this location on February 25, 2004. This license expired on May 31, 2004.
3. From February 25, 2004 and continuing on through April 8, 2004, Hauper Pharmacy operated as a pharmacy at its new location, 4310 67<sup>th</sup> Drive, Union Grove, WI 53182, without a valid Wisconsin pharmacy license.
4. In resolution of this matter, Hauper Pharmacy consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 450.10, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 227.44(5).

2. The conduct described in paragraph 3, above, constitutes a violation of Wisconsin Administrative Code § Phar 6.02 and Wis. Stats. § 450.06.

## ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The license of Hauper Pharmacy (license #42-8389) is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. Hauper Pharmacy shall pay costs in the amount of \$100.00, within 30 days of the date of this Final Decision and Order.

3. Hauper Pharmacy shall forfeit the sum of \$410.00 to be paid to the Department of Regulation and Licensing, 1400 E. Washington Avenue, P.O. Box 8935, Madison, Wisconsin, 53708-8935, within 30 days of the date of this Final Decision and Order.

4. In the event the Respondent fails to pay costs as ordered the Respondent's license SHALL BE SUSPENDED without further notice or hearing, until the Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

5. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
