# PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Veterinary Examining Board. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

# **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. Lisa H. Kluslow, D.V.M., (DOB 01/01/1969) is duly licensed to practice veterinary medicine in the state of Wisconsin (license #50-5241). This license was first granted on May 22, 2001.
- 2. Ms. Kluslow's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board is 9513 North Swan Road, Milwaukee, WI 53024.
- 3. At all times relevant to this action, Ms. Kluslow was working as a veterinarian for Best Friends Veterinary Center, 2082 Cheyenne Court, Grafton, Wisconsin.
- 4. Dr. Kluslow practiced with an expired Wisconsin veterinary medicine license (#50-5241) from approximately January 1, 2004 and continuing on to September 16, 2004, when the license was renewed.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Veterinary Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis, Stats. § 453.04 and Wis. Stats. § 453.07. and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 227.44 (5).
- The conduct described in paragraph 4, above, constitutes a violation of Wisconsin Administrative Code § VE 2. 7.06 (20).

# **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation of the parties, as attached hereto, is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Lisa H. Kluslow, D.V.M. is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Lisa H. Kluslow, D.V.M. shall pay costs in the amount of ONE HUNDRED dollars (\$100.00). Payment shall be submitted within sixty (60) days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by certified check or money order, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

The rights of a party aggrieved by this Decision to petition the Board for rehearing and to petition for judicial review are set forth in the attached "Notice of Appeal Information."

Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event the Respondent fails to pay costs as ordered the Respondent's license SHALL BE SUSPENDED until the Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order shall become effective on the date of its signing.
