The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision in this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. John D. Walsh (Date of Birth: April 6, 1940) possesses a certificate of licensure and a certificate of certification to practice in the state of Wisconsin as a Certified Residential Appraiser and Licensed Appraiser in the state of Wisconsin (number 9-337). These certificates were first granted on January 9, 1992, and are current through December 31, 2005.
- 2. John D. Walsh (Date of Birth: April 6, 1940) possesses a certificate of licensure and a certificate of certification to practice in the state of Wisconsin as a Certified General Appraiser and Licensed Appraiser in the state of Wisconsin (number 10-454). These certificates were first granted on August 4, 1993, and are current through December 31, 2005.
- 3. Mr. Walsh's most recent address known to the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 1410 Falcon Place, New Richmond, WI 54017.
- 4. In 2001, Mr. Walsh's certificate of certification to practice as a Certified General Appraiser was limited by the Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board. Mr. Walsh's certificate of certification to practice as a Certified General Appraiser is still limited by the 2001 discipline.
- 5. Mr. Walsh has notified the Department of Regulation and Licensing of his intent to surrender his certificate of

certification to practice as a Certified General Appraiser in the state of Wisconsin. Mr. Walsh wishes to maintain his certificate of licensure and certificate of certification to practice as a Certified Residential Appraiser and Licensed Appraiser.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board has jurisdiction over this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. Sec. 458.26.
- 2. The Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board is authorized to enter into the attached stipulation, pursuant to Wis. Stat. sec. 227.44(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board ACCEPTS the surrender of the certificate of certification of John D. Walsh to practice as a Certified General Appraiser in the state of Wisconsin (number #10-454).
- 2. All certificates of certification to practice as a General Certificate Appraiser shall be returned to the Department Monitor, Post Office Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.
- 3. The effective date of the board's Order is the date of signing by the Board's chair or his designee.
