PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Pharmacy Examining Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Sheryl Ann Aufenkamp, R.Ph., (DOB 02/10/1964) is duly licensed as a pharmacist in the state of Wisconsin (license #40-11327). This license was granted on 01/09/1990.
- 2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board is 1003 N. Dakota Street #8, Aberdeen, SD 57401.
- 3. At all times relevant to this action, Respondent was working as a pharmacist at Option Care in the State of Michigan.
- 4. On March 8, 2004, Respondent entered into an Order with the Michigan State Board of Pharmacy. This Order reprimanded Respondent and placed her on probation for one year or until she completed five hours of continuing education. The factual basis for the imposition of discipline against Respondent in Michigan involved Respondent's failure to keep the area designated for controlled substance storage locked while there was not a pharmacist on duty. A true and correct copy of

the Michigan Board's Order is attached to this document as Exhibit A. Exhibit A is incorporated into this document by reference.

- 5. Ms. Aufenkamp has complied with all terms of the Michigan Board's Order and effective May 17, 2004 holds an unrestricted license to practice as a pharmacist in the State of Michigan.
- 6. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 450.10, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stats. 227.44(5).
- 2. The conduct described in paragraph 4, above, constitutes a violation of Wisconsin Administrative Code § Phar 10.03(17).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Sheryl Ann Aufenkamp, R.Ph. (license #40-11327), is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. Respondent shall, within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars. Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:
