### PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. Lisa J. Kirschbaum, R.N., (DOB 02/13/1963) is duly licensed as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin (license #30-129258). This license was first granted on 04/14/1998.
- 2. Ms. Kirschbaum's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is 942 Valley View Drive, Lancaster, WI 53813.
- 3. At all times relevant to this action, Ms. Kirschbaum was working as a registered nurse for Ennoble Manor in Dubuque, Iowa.
- 4. On April 10, 1998, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing entered into an order requiring in part that Ms. Kirschbaum

submit quarterly reports to be submitted from her nursing employer(s) reporting the terms and conditions of her employment and evaluating her work performance. These reports were to be submitted to the Department Monitor in the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement.

- 5. The limitations on the license, including quarterly work reports, became effective on April 10, 1998 and were to continue until April 1, 2004, or until Ms. Kirschbaum was released from parole and/or probation in connection with her April 11, 1994, conviction, whichever was later. Ms. Kirschbaum was released from probation on April 11, 2004.
- 6. During calendar year 2003, only one quarterly work report was submitted to the Department Monitor.

# **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. §441.07,[smg1] and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- 2. The failures to arrange for quarterly work reports as described in paragraph 6, above, constitute violations of Wisconsin Administrative Code § N 7.04(14).

#### <u>ORDER</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Lisa J. Kirschbaum, R.N., is REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. Respondent shall, within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) dollars. Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:

Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event the Respondent fails to pay costs as ordered the Respondent's license SHALL BE SUSPENDED until the Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.
