PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Marge M. Seibel, L.P.N., (DOB 07/30/2962) is duly licensed as a practical nurse in the state of Wisconsin (license # 31 28390). This license was first granted on 11/27/1985.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is 1330 Western Street, Oshkosh, Wisconsin.
3. At all times relevant to this action, Respondent was working as a licensed practical nurse in Oshkosh, Wisconsin.
4. In or about May through August of 2003, Respondent worked for Aurora Health Care. She was a patient as well as an employee.

5. Respondent became addicted to narcotic drugs and requested prescriptions from her coworkers.
6. Respondent took her patient file, altered prescription records, and kept the file in her own file cabinet, in an attempt to mislead coworkers who were prescribing for her about the extent of her prescriptions.
7. Respondent thereby manipulated coworkers into prescribing excessive amounts of narcotics for her by altering her patient records.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
2. The conduct described in paragraphs 4 - 7 above constitutes a violation of Wisconsin Administrative Code § N 7.04(2).

### ORDER

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The stipulation of the parties is approved.
2. The Board of Nursing accepts the surrender of the license of Marge M. Seibel, L.P.N. (license # 31 28390), to practice as a nurse in the State of Wisconsin.
3. In the event that Ms. Seibel re-applies for Wisconsin licensure as a nurse in the future, the Board may enter an denying such application without further notice or hearing.
4. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
