PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Department of Regulation and Licensing (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable. Accordingly, the Department in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. **Donald C. Evers**, date of birth March 10, 1936, was issued a Private Security Permit in the State of Wisconsin, license number 108-18793, on October 5, 2001. That permit is current until August 31, 2006. Mr. Evers' address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 3636 South 23rd Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53221. The Department has learned that Mr. Evers is presently residing at 4413 West Bottsford Avenue, Greenfield WI 53220.

2. **Metropolitan Police Services of America, L.L.C.**, was issued a Private Detective Agency license in the State of Wisconsin, license number 62-16226, on August 16, 2002. That license is current until August 31, 2006. Metropolitan Police Services of America, L.L.C.'s (Metropolitan) address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is Post Office Box 370365, Milwaukee, WI 53237. The Department has learned that Metropolitan is located at 1126 South 70th Street, Number 100, West Allis, WI 53214. Department records indicate that the owners of Metropolitan are Theresa E. Peltier and Donald C. Evers.

3. The liability insurance coverage for Metropolitan expired on July 26, 2005.

4. On exact dates unknown, but at least during December 2004, Deshon L. Olivier was employed as a security guard with Metropolitan. Mr. Olivier has never held a Wisconsin Private Security Permit.

5. On exact dates unknown, but at least during portions of 2005, Bashamba Williams was employed as a security guard with Metropolitan. Mr. Williams has never held a Wisconsin Private Security Permit.

6. At times unknown, but at least on July 25, 2005, Jermain A. Moore was employed as a security guard with Metropolitan. Mr. Moore has never held a Wisconsin Private Security Permit.

7. During the summer of 2005, numerous payroll checks were written on a Metropolitan bank account to employees. A large number of checks were returned by the Port Washington State Bank to the employees bearing the stamp of "Non-Sufficient Funds" and "DO NOT PRESENT AGAIN."

8. In June and July 2005, Metropolitan attempted to pay their liability insurance premium with checks that did not have sufficient funds deposited to redeem it.

9. From January 1, 2005 to August 2, 2005, Metropolitan had 153 checks drawn on the Port Washington State Bank account returned by the Bank as having insufficient funds to redeem them.

10. During 2004 and 2005, the Metropolitan internet website advertised "Plainclothes Operatives" and "Undercover" services. At no time did Metropolitan have a licensed private detective on staff to provide the advertised services.

11. Mr. Evers neither admits nor denies the facts stated above in paragraphs 3 - 10, but agrees to the entry of this Final Decision and Order.

12. Mr. Evers wishes to resolve these six cases by voluntarily surrendering his personal Private Security Permit (#108-18793) and any associated Firearms Permit, and the Private Detective Agency license issued to Metropolitan Police Services of America, L.L.C. (#62-16226), including and the right to renew these licenses or seek relicensure in the future.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The State of Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of the Private Security Permit of **Donald C. Evers** (permit #108-18793) and any associated Firearms Permit, and the Private Detective Agency license of **Metropolitan Police Services of America, L.L.C.** (license #62-16226), be, and hereby are ACCEPTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. All rights and privileges granted to **Donald C. Evers** pursuant to Private Security Permit #108-20458 and any associated Firearms Permit are forever terminated, effective at 11:59 p.m. on the date of this order.

3. **Donald C. Evers** shall not seek to renew his Private Security Permit or apply for a Private Security Permit with the State of Wisconsin, Department of Regulation and Licensing, in the future. **Donald C. Evers** shall not seek to become an employee, owner, manager, partner, investor, corporate officer or member of any corporate board involving any Private Detective Agency within the State of Wisconsin, and shall not have any involvement whatsoever in the private security industry or private detective industry in the State of Wisconsin.

4. All rights and privileges granted to **Metropolitan Police Services of America, L.L.C.** pursuant to Private Detective Agency license #62-16226 are forever terminated, effective at 11:59 p.m. on the date of this order.

5. **Metropolitan Police Services of America, L.L.C.** shall not seek to renew its Private Detective Agency license or apply for licensure as a Private Detective Agency with the State of Wisconsin, Department of Regulation and Licensing, in the future.

6. In its discretion the Department may, in the alternative, impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order.

7. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
