On December 7, 2005, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Charlene Willis, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension of her license to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* (“*Order*”) dated October 10, 1995.

Also requested by Willis was a decrease in the frequency of urine drug screens required by the *Order*, currently at 48 times per year and an increase in the number of hours to be worked unsupervised as a pharmacist in charge, currently at 32 hours per week, which was unsupported by her employer . Based upon the board’s review:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Charlene Willis, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #11555 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to reduce the frequency of the urine drug screens required by the *Order* to (36) thirty six times per year, is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for an increase in the number of hours to work unsupervised as a pharmacist in charge, currently at 32, is denied.
