On October 19, 2004, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Charlene Willis, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension of her license to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* (“*Order*”) dated October 10, 1995.

Also requested by Willis was a decrease in the frequency of individual/group therapy sessions to one time every three months. (currently at one time every other month) The request was impliedly supported by her therapist.

Based upon the board’s review:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Charlene Willis, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #11555 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for a decrease in the frequency of individual/group therapy sessions to one time every three months, is granted.
