On February 9, 2005, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by John R. Schmitt, R.Ph., for a stay of suspension of his license to practice pharmacy as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order*, ("*Order*") dated August 13, 1997. Schmitt also petitioned to reduce the required individual/group therapy required by paragraph 2.b.(2) of the *Order*, and the request was supported by his therapist. Schmitt also requested a reduction in drug screening frequency, which was not addressed by his therapist. Based upon the board's review of the documentation submitted:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that John R. Schmitt, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #8852 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the petition to reduce the current frequency of individual/group therapy is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the petition to reduce drug screening frequency, is denied.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Schmitt shall cause to have submitted for review by the board at its April, 2005 meeting, a plan of care report from his treating physician. The report shall be sent to the board in care of the department monitor.
