On December 7, 2005, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by William Karwoski, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension as provided within the board's Final Decision and Order ("Order") dated March 10, 1999. Also requested was the removal of any restrictions from acting as a pharmacist in charge, (paragraph 2.c.(3)), and a reduction in urine drug screens required by the Order to a frequency of (12) twelve times per year.

Based upon the board's review:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that William Karwoski, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #9334 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to the remove the current restrictions from acting as a pharmacist in charge, (paragraph 2.c.(3)), is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to reduce the urine drug screens required by the *Order* to a frequency of (12) twelve times per year, is denied.
