PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter, Debbie Padilla, D.V.M., Respondent, and Pamela M. Stach, Attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Debbie Padilla, DVM, (D/O/B 5/27/65) is currently licensed to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Wisconsin under license #5098 which was granted on May 23, 2000.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board is Sparta Veterinary Clinic, 1701 W. Wisconsin ST, Sparta, WI 54656.
3. At all times relevant to this action, Respondent was working as a veterinarian in Sparta, Wisconsin.
4. A formal investigation entitled 03 Vet 070 is pending before the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board.
5. The investigation includes allegations of failure by the Respondent to provide sufficient fluid therapy to a male dog diagnosed with dehydration on presentation.
6. Respondent has cooperated throughout this investigation and, in order to resolve this matter, has voluntarily agreed to entry of this Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 453.04, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Stipulation of the parties, as attached hereto, is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that

1. Debbie Padilla, D.V.M. shall, within nine months of the effective date of this Order, complete 8 hours of education in the identification and treatment of critical care patients with an emphasis on fluid therapy. Courses conducted via the internet or by other electronic means of communication or courses conducted by correspondence or through a home study program may be considered if, in the opinion of the Board or its delegate, the courses are adequate to meet the ordered reeducation. The courses may not be used in satisfaction of the biennial continuing education requirement for continued licensure.

2. Dr. Padilla shall be responsible for locating the course/s required under this Order, for providing adequate course descriptions to the Department Monitor and for obtaining pre-approval of the course/s from the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board prior to commencement of the programs. The Board may reject in whole or in part any educational opportunity which is nominated by Dr. Padilla when, in the Board's judgment, the syllabus or description of the course or other educational opportunity is insufficient to fulfill the purpose for which Dr. Padilla nominates it by reason of the educational opportunity's scope, content, method of instruction, or degree of participation required of students. The Board shall not unreasonably deny an educational opportunity suggested by Dr. Padilla.

3. Within 30 days after the course/s identified in paragraph one above are concluded, Dr. Padilla shall file with the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board certifications from the sponsoring organization of his attendance at the required course/s.

4. All costs of the educational programs shall be the responsibility of the Dr. Padilla.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Padilla shall pay costs in this matter of Six Hundred forty one dollars (\$641.00) within ninety (90) days of the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the pending investigation 03 VET 070 is hereby closed.

Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to pay costs as ordered or fails to comply with the ordered continuing education the Respondent's license (#5098) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
