Based upon the Stipulation and information of record herein, the Department adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. William r. Lawrence, Jr. (Applicant) has filed an application for renewal of his credential to practice as a private security person in Wisconsin.
- 2. Information received in the application process reflects that on or about March 29, 2006 Applicant was charged with violati Wis. Stat. §§ 940.19(1) and 947.01 [battery and disorderly conduct]. These criminal matters are still pending.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26.
- 2. The facts and circumstances of the arrest referenced above substantially relate to the practice of a private security person. Applicant by his conduct is subject to action against his license pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that WILLIAM R. LAWRENCE JR. is GRANTED renewal of a PRIVATE SECURITY PERMIT subject to the following LIMITATIONS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Reporting Requirements

- 1. Applicant shall provide a copy of this Final Decision and Order to all employers where Applicant works as a private security person.
- 2. Applicant shall comply with all terms of probation and/or parole imposed upon him, and make arrangements with his probation/parole officer to notify the Department Monitor **immediately** of any violation of probation/parole terms. In addition, Applicant shall make arrangements for the submission of quarterly reports from his probation/parole office attesting to the status of his participation in probation/parole. Applicant shall provide the Board with current releases complying with state and federal laws, authorizing release and access to her probation and parole records.
- 5. Applicant shall report to the Department any change of employment status, residence, address or telephone number within five (5) days of the date of a change.
- 6. Applicant is responsible for compliance with all of the terms and conditions of this Order, including the timely submission of reports by others. Applicant shall promptly notify Department Monitor of any suspected violations of any of the terms and conditions of this Order by Applicant

7. The Department Monitor is the individual designated by the department as its agent to coordinate compliance with the terms of this Order. Any requests, petitions, reports and other information required by this Order shall be mailed, e-mailed, faxed or delivered to:

Petitions for Modification

8. Applicant may petition the Department for modification of the terms of this Order after one year from the effective date of this order. Any such petition shall be accompanied by a written recommendation from Applicant's probation officer, supporting the specific modifications sought. Denial of a petition in whole or in part shall not be considered a denial of a license within the meaning of §227.01(3)(a), Stat., and Applicant shall not have a right to any further hearings or proceedings on the denial.

Costs of Compliance

9 Applicant shall be responsible for all costs and expenses incurred in conjunction with or associated with compliance with the terms of this Order.

Summary Suspension / Additional Discipline

10. The Department may in its discretion revoke Applicant's limited license without further notice or hearing or other proceeding if Applicant fails to timely comply with the terms of this Order and/or upon any further criminal conviction of Applicant. Violations of this Order may in the alternative be the basis for a summary suspension under Wis. Admin. Code § RL 6 or separate disciplinary action under Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6).
