FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Ryan R. Pellicane (Applicant) has filed an application for a credential to practice as a private security person in Wisconsin.
2. Information received in the application process reflects that:
 - a. On or about January 27, 2003 Applicant was convicted of violation of Wis. Stat. §§ 943.01(1), 943.20(1)(a) and 943.1(1) [criminal damage to property, theft-movable property <=\$2500, and entry into/onto bldg/construct.site/room]

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26.
2. The facts and circumstances of the conviction referenced above substantially relate to the practice of a private security person. Applicant by his conduct is subject to action against his license pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that RYAN R. PELLICANE is GRANTED a PRIVATE SECURITY PERMIT subject to the following LIMITATIONS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Practice Limitations

1. Applicant shall provide a copy of this Final Decision and Order immediately to supervisory personnel at all settings where Applicant works or applies to work as a private security person.
2. Applicant shall work only in settings pre-approved by the Department.

Reporting Requirements

3. It is Applicant's responsibility to arrange for his security guard supervisor(s) to provide reports to the Department Monitor on a quarterly basis, as directed by Department Monitor. These reports shall describe the Applicant's activities and verify that he is in compliance with the laws governing the practice of a private security person and the terms of this Order. Applicant's supervisors shall report immediately to the Department Monitor any violation or suspected violation of this Order.
4. Applicant shall report to the Department any change of employment status, residence, address or telephone number within five (5) days of the date of a change.
5. Applicant is responsible for compliance with all of the terms and conditions of this Order, including the timely submission of reports by others. Applicant shall promptly notify Department Monitor of any suspected violations of any of the terms and conditions of this Order by Applicant

DEPARTMENT MONITOR

6. The Department Monitor is the individual designated by the department as its agent to coordinate compliance with the terms of this Order. Any requests, petitions, reports and other information required by this Order shall be mailed, e-

Petitions for Modification

7. Applicant may petition the Department for modification of the terms of this Order after one year from the effective date of this order. Denial of a petition in whole or in part shall not be considered a denial of a license within the meaning of §227.01(3)(a), Stat., and Applicant shall not have a right to any further hearings or proceedings on the denial.

Costs of Compliance

8. Applicant shall be responsible for all costs and expenses incurred in conjunction with or associated with compliance with the terms of this Order.

Summary Suspension

9. The Department may revoke Applicant's limited license, without further notice or hearing or other proceedings, for failure by Applicant to comply with the terms of this order, or for any further criminal conviction of Applicant. A violation of any term of this Order may in the alternative be the basis for a summary suspension under Wis. Admin. Code § RL 6 or separate disciplinary action under Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6).
