PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On February 1, 2005, the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing issued to Petitioner a limited license to practice as a Real Estate Broker in the State of Wisconsin. According to records on file with the Department Monitor, Petitioner has fully complied with all limitations imposed. Petitioner has requested a modification of the reporting requirements associated with his license.

Accordingly, the Department of Regulation and Licensing issues the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

The Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing REVISES AND MODIFIES the terms and conditions of the real estate broker's license of ROBERTO M. RODRIGUEZ as follows:

Required reporting

If Mr. Rodriguez engages in practice in Wisconsin other than in transactions where he represents himself and only himself as purchaser, he shall make arrangements for the submission of quarterly reports in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Department's original grant of a broker's license.


Mr. Rodriguez shall report to the Department Monitor any change in employment status, change of residence address or phone number, within fifteen (15) days of any such change.

Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § RL 4.09, Mr. Rodriguez shall notify the Department in writing of the date, place and nature of any conviction of a misdemeanor or felony in this state or elsewhere within 48 hours after the entry of the judgment of conviction.

All other terms, conditions and limitations as set forth in the Department's original grant of a broker's license shall remain in effect.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
