As reported by the department monitor to the board liaison for monitoring, test results for drug and alcohol monitoring for Duane A. Oestreich evidence that on November 30, 2005, December 9, 2005 and December 23, 2005, Oestreich tested positive for opiates and benzodiazepines. The board liaison for monitoring therefore finds that Duane A. Oestreich is in violation of paragraph 2.a. of the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated December 10, 2002. ("Order") Based on the foregoing:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that pursuant to paragraph 8 of the *Order*, the stay of suspension for Duane A. Oestreich of license #8131, to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin, is hereby TERMINATED by action of the board liaison for monitoring.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the board, the termination of the stay of suspension of Duane A. Oestreich shall be reviewed by the board for further action.

PLEASE BE ADVISED: Pursuant to paragraph 8 of the *Order* a licensee who has a stay of suspension terminated pursuant to paragraph 8 has the opportunity to be heard before the board. The next regularly scheduled board meeting is February 8, 2006.
