On November 16, 2006, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing considered information related to the petitioner's stay of the suspension of her nursing licenses, pursuant to the order of the Board dated February 7, 2003. Based upon all information of record which indicated that the petitioner had been terminated from her employment and had not given proper notice to the Board, and that the petitioner had stopped attending therapy sessions, the Board now orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for three month stay of the suspension of the license of LOIS J. BOYD, (lic.# 94643) to practice as a registered nurse (RN) and as an Advanced Practice Nurse Prescriber (APNP) (lic.# 1531) in Wisconsin, is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petitioner shall submit a hair specimen for drug testing in addition to her urine screens. This order is effective five (5) days after the date signed below.
