### ORDER GRANTING A STAY OF SUSPENSION

TO: Karen L. Doering 6925 Sunset Road Kohler, WI 53044

On July 15, 2005, the Physical Therapists Affiliated Credentialing (Board) issued a Final Decision and Order in the abovecaptioned matter. By the terms of the Board's Order, Ms. Doering's license to practice physical therapy was suspended for a minimum of five years, subject to a petition for renewable stays of suspension provided Ms. Doering was in compliance with the terms of the Order. Among the conditions of the Order, Ms. Doering, upon initial application for a stay of suspension, must provide proof that she has maintained continuous sobriety for at least three months and that she successfully participating in a treatment program acceptable to the Board.

On July 13, 2006, the Physical Therapists Affiliated Credentialing Board reviewed the request of Karen L. Doering, P.T., for a stay of suspension and a reduction in the required number of urinalyses, along with supporting documentation from her various treatment providers.

Based upon the Board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Karen L. Doering is granted a three month stay of suspension to practice physical therapy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a reduction in urinalyses to not less than two (2) times per month is granted.

Please be advised that the next submission of reports and the petition for an extension of a stay of suspension are due on October 15, 2006.
