On June 22, 2006, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed a petition and supporting evidence submitted by Michael Hiller, R.Ph., in support of a request for the granting of a three month stay of suspension as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order*, ("*Order*") dated August 11, 2004, in case number LS 0408114 PHM. Also requested was 1) a reduction in therapy sessions as required by paragraph 2.b.(2) of the *Order* (currently every other week); 2) 16 hours per week of work as a pharmacist in charge (currently 8 hours); and 3) Permission to open and close a pharmacy consecutively as a pharmacist in charge. Based upon the board's review of the petition and the documents submitted, the board orders as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Michael Hiller, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #10177 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the request for a reduction in therapy sessions as required by paragraph 2.b.(2) of the *Order*, to one time per month, is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That effective September 1, 2006, Hiller is granted sixteen (16) hours of work per week as a pharmacist in charge. Hiller may open and close a pharmacy but NOT consecutively.
