On July 12, 2006, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board (Board) issued a Final Decision and Order revoking the license of Allen Richard Welsh, DDS. On August 14, 2006 Dr. Welsh filed an Appeal for Rehearing with the Board pursuant to Wis. Stat. s. 227.49. On September 6, 2006, the Dentistry Examining Board reviewed Dr. Welsh's Appeal for Rehearing and voted to deny his appeal.

The Board can only grant a rehearing if it finds one of the grounds listed in Wis. Stat. s. 227.49(3), which reads as follows:

#### 227.49 Petitions for rehearing in contested cases.

- (3) Rehearing will be granted only on the basis of:
  - (a) Some material error of law.
  - (b) Some material error of fact.
  - (c) The discovery of new evidence sufficiently strong to reverse or modify the order, and which could not have been previously discovered by due diligence.

After reviewing and considering the documents submitted by Dr. Welsh the Board members found that there was no evidence of a material error of fact or law in the original decision and there was no new evidence submitted that would cause the Board to change its decision or that could not have been previously discovered by due diligence.

**ORDER** 

THEREFORE, the Board Orders that Dr. Welsh's petition for rehearing is DENIED.
