PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Dentistry Examining Board. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Alessandro Savaglio, Jr., DDS, ("Respondent") was born on December 5, 1960, and is licensed to practice dentistry in the state of Wisconsin pursuant to license number 3636, first granted on June 27, 1986.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board is 4039 80th Street, Suite C, Kenosha, Wisconsin 53142.
3. At all times relevant to this action, Respondent was working as a dentist at Kenosha, Wisconsin.
4. On three occasions between May 1, 2001 and July 12, 2002, Respondent filed insurance claims for dental services provided to Patient D.O., a male born October 30, 1983.
5. The insurance claims contained inaccurate representations about services provided to Patient D.O., resulting in overpayment for services actually provided.
6. Respondent carried the overpayment on his records for Patient D.O. and applied the overpayment to future dental services actually provided to Patient D.O. and his family.
7. On two occasions between November 28, 1998 and January 30, 2002, Respondent provided dental treatment to Patient T.S., a female born April 17, 1995.
8. Respondent filed insurance claims containing inaccurate representations about services provided to Patient T.S., resulting in overpayment for services actually provided to Patient T.S.
9. Respondent carried the overpayment on his records for Patient T.S. and applied the overpayment to future dental services actually provided to Patient T.S. and her family.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 447.07 and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
2. The conduct described in paragraph(s) 4 through 9 above, constitutes a violation of Wis. Stat. § 447.07(3)(k).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Alessandro Savaglio, Jr., DDS, is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. Respondent shall, within 180 days from the date of this Order, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

3. Respondent shall, within 180 days from the date of this Order, pay a forfeiture in the amount of Five Hundred (\$500.00) dollars. Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to the address specified in paragraph 2 of this Order, above.

4. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit any payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, or fails to pay costs as ordered, the Respondent's license(#3636) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

5. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
